Wishes to all for a healthy and prosperous new year.

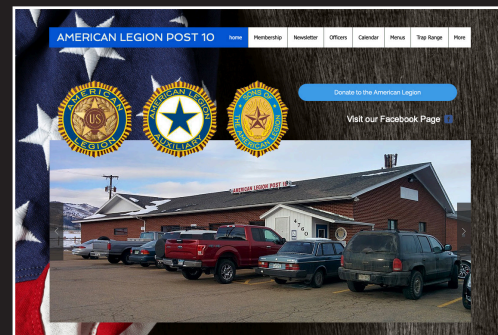
